



The Center for Biotechnology and the Department of Biomedical Engineering in the College of Engineering and Applied Sciences are pleased to announce the Goddard Family Charitable Foundation Scholarship. The Goddard Family Charitable Foundation Scholarship will be given to up to five Biomedical Engineering students in the 2013-2014 academic year. The scholarship, in the amount of \$5,000, will be given in two installments of \$2,500 contingent upon the student's academic performance. This scholarship will allow students the unique opportunity to focus full-time on academic performance, research, and the opportunities that will be offered to scholarship recipients. The Goddard Scholarship will provide the selected students with opportunities to develop skills in communication, business, research and industry to help foster future leaders in Biomedical Engineering.

To qualify for the Goddard Family Scholarship, interested students must be:

- A. Women enrolled as a full-time Undergraduate student majoring in Biomedical Engineering in the College of Engineering and Applied Sciences for the full 2013-2014 academic year or in their graduate career in a 5-yr combined or sequential Biomedical Engineering degree program; Women in Science & Engineering (WISE) members are encouraged to apply;
- B. Have maintained a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.4;
- C. Be enrolled and an active participate in Biomedical Engineering Research (BME 499) for a minimum of 2 credits each semester.

Interested candidates should submit the following documents:

1. A completed application form.
2. A narrative personal statement of approximately two pages that includes the following information:
 - Your interests in biomedical engineering and career goals.
 - Your qualifications for this award.
 - Relevant information about your financial need (official documents are not required).
3. Two reference letters from faculty or a program director.
4. A resume.
5. List of honors and awards.
6. A copy of your unofficial transcript.
7. A Signed FERPA Form.

Applications are due no later than April 5, 2013 at 5 p.m.
